




EBooks and Audiobooks with Libby





Libby is the latest eBook app from Overdrive and is a new and simpler way to download, read and listen to eBooks and audiobooks. You need to have a library ticket to use this service – you can join in any branch or get an online only membership at www.librariesni.org.uk. Libby can be downloaded for free from the App or Google Play stores (search "Libby by Overdrive") If you have already borrowed titles using Overdrive, they should automatically appear in the Libby app when you sign in with your library card number.

1. GETTING SET UP











Tap on the **guides** to see what titles are in that collection

You can also **browse** titles by genre, subject and so on **here** – tap **subjects** to see the full list



3. DOWNLOADING

If the title is on loan, tap place hold to reserve it — tap the little calendar icon beside, to see how long the wait list is



Choose a book and read the blurb by tapping on the cover —
Tap borrow to download the title to your device

After borrowing a title, tap **Keep Browsing** to choose another title, or **Open Book/Go to Shelf** to read or listen

All your loans are here for you to read, listen, renew and return






